

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Town of Brookhaven, Department of Housing and Community Development will be accepting applications for the Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher Program. To be eligible, the household must meet the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development's (HUD) definition of a family, which includes a single person or a group of persons residing together. The applicant must have U. S. citizenship or meet eligible immigration status with supporting documentation. To qualify, an applicant family must meet all program criteria and must not exceed the following income limits:

This application period will begin at 9:00 am EST on Monday, March 8, 2021 and end on Friday, March 12, 2021 at 5:00 pm EST. Applicants may use any computer, tablet or smartphone with internet access to apply. Applications will be available at the Town of Brookhaven's website at www.brookhavenny.gov.

All successfully submitted applications will be placed on the Section 8 Waiting List. Using a random lottery process, all applications will be assigned a position on the Waiting List using the following preferences:

- Living in the Town of Brookhaven, and/or
- Working or hired to work in the Town of Brookhaven.
