Applications will be selected by lottery; applicants who submit more than one application will be disqualified. Eligible households that include persons with mobility impairments will receive preference for 5% of the units; eligible households that include persons with visual and/or hearing impairments will receive preference for 2% of the units. A recording of the lottery will be posted on the website after
